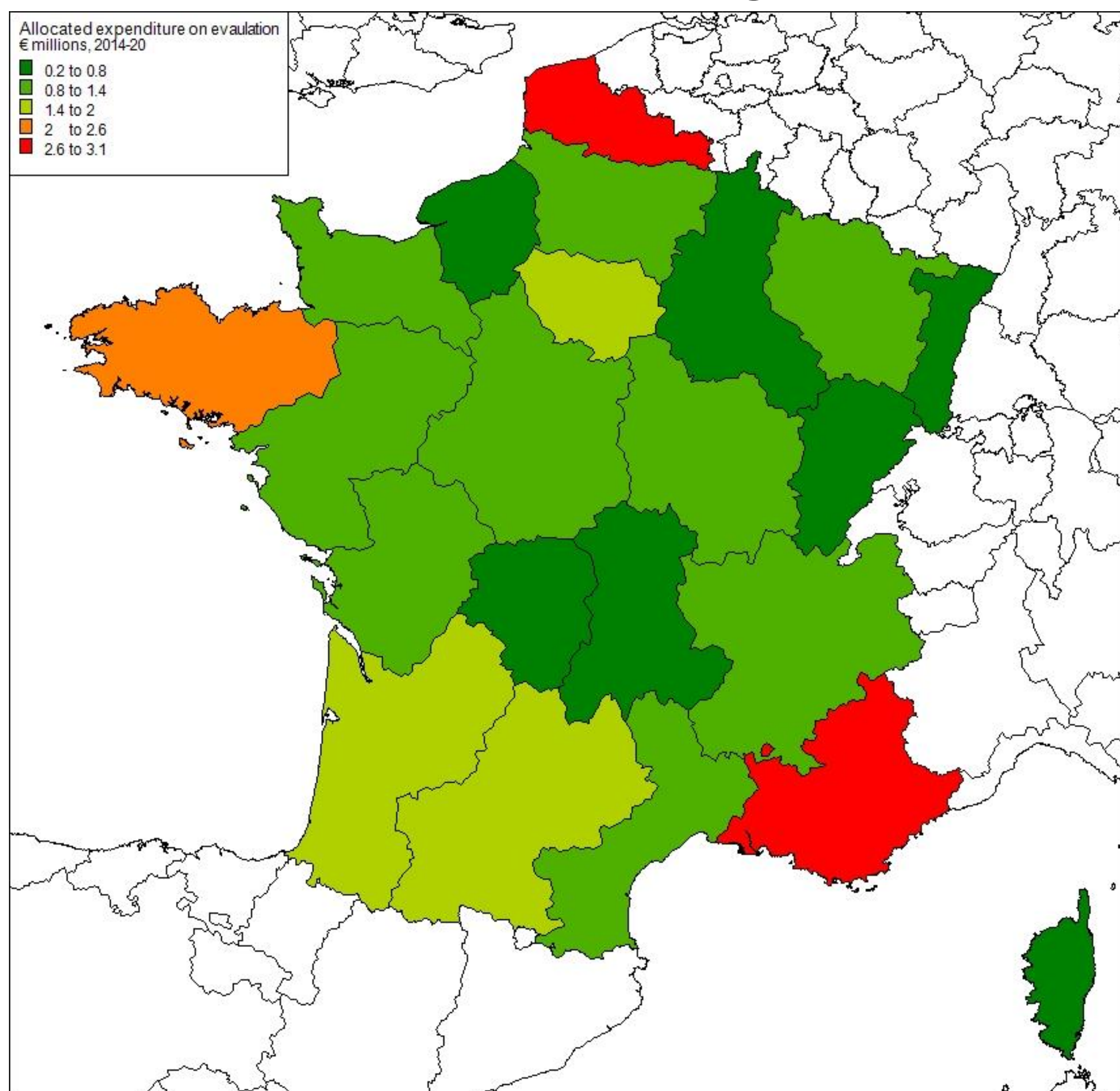


# Regional evaluation plans in France 2014-20

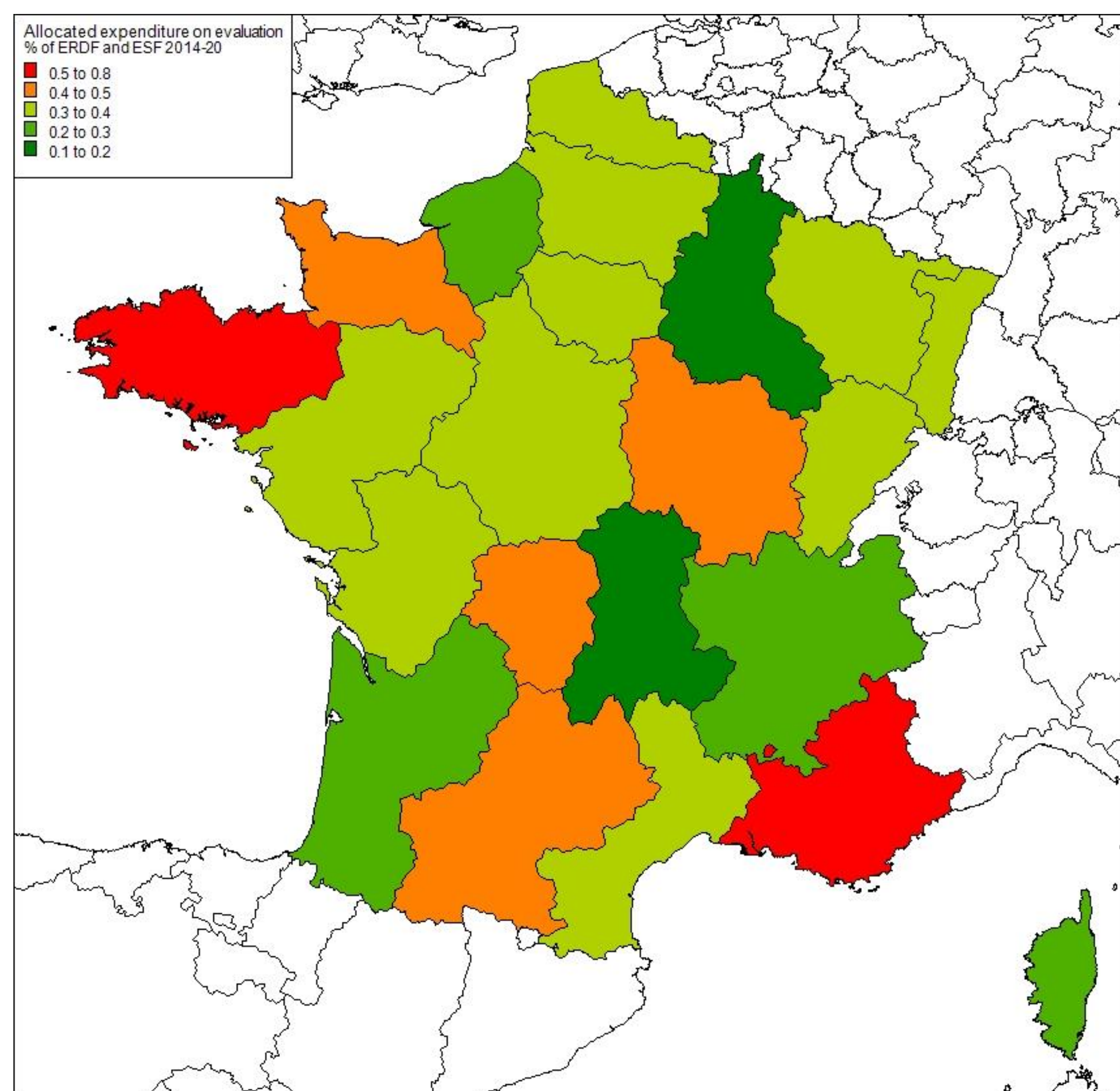
As a result of a decentralisation reform in 2014, the management of the ERDF, the EAFRD and 35% of the ESF envelopes have been transferred to the Regions. Monitoring and evaluation activities are the responsibility of each regional managing authority. However, the CGET (ex-Datar) remains involved as the national coordinating body and as the national authority responsible for ERDF. As such it co-chairs the National State-Regions Committees, and is in charge of the coordination of the regional monitoring and evaluation outputs. It also manages the national Technical Assistance OP, which funds support to the Regions in terms of monitoring and evaluation. This includes capacity-building (e.g. training sessions), methodological guides on evaluation, indicators and studies.

## Indicative amount\* of EU funding for evaluation...

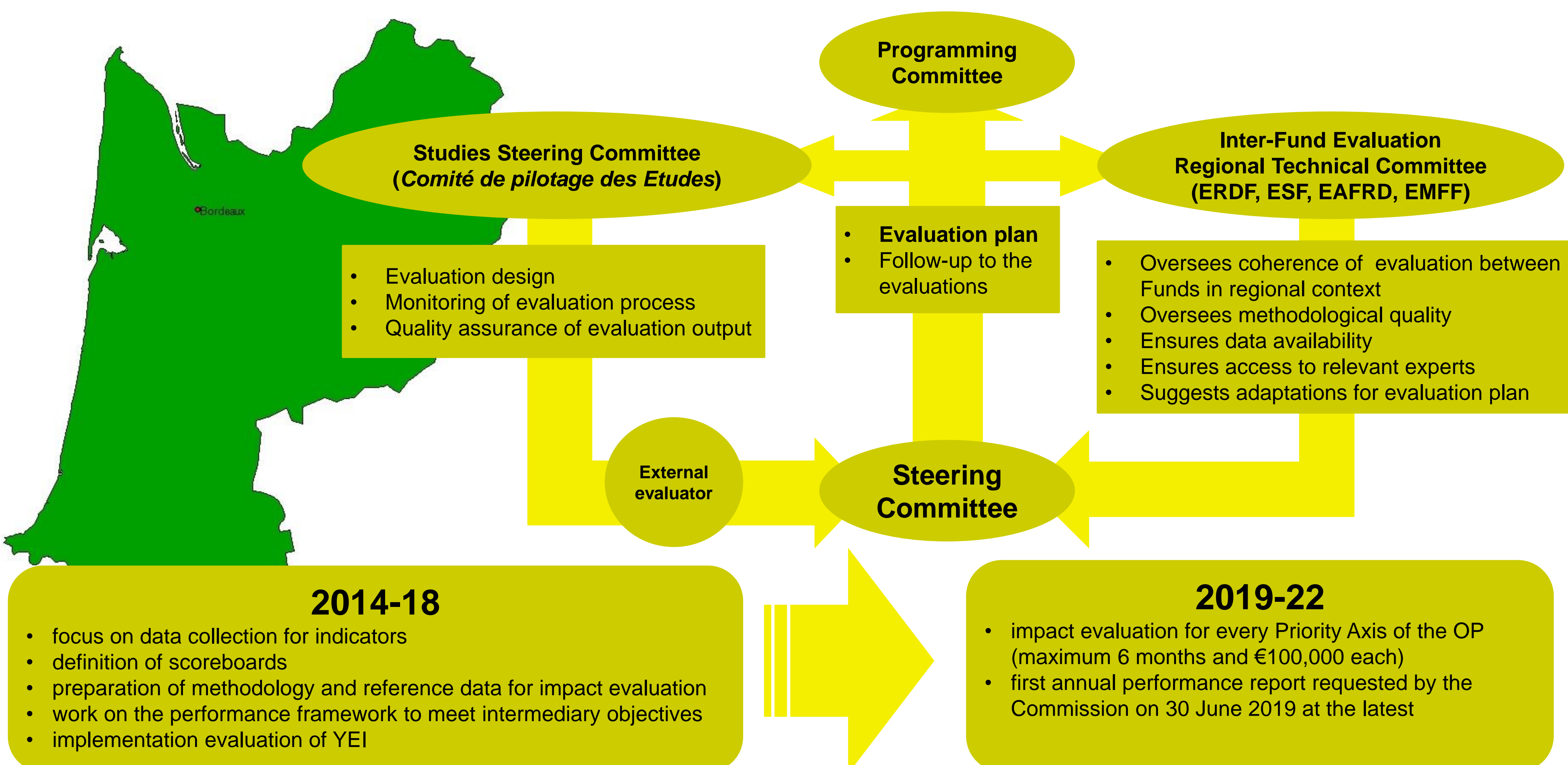


\* Only ERDF and ESF and without staff costs dedicated to evaluation
