Situation 2007 – 2013

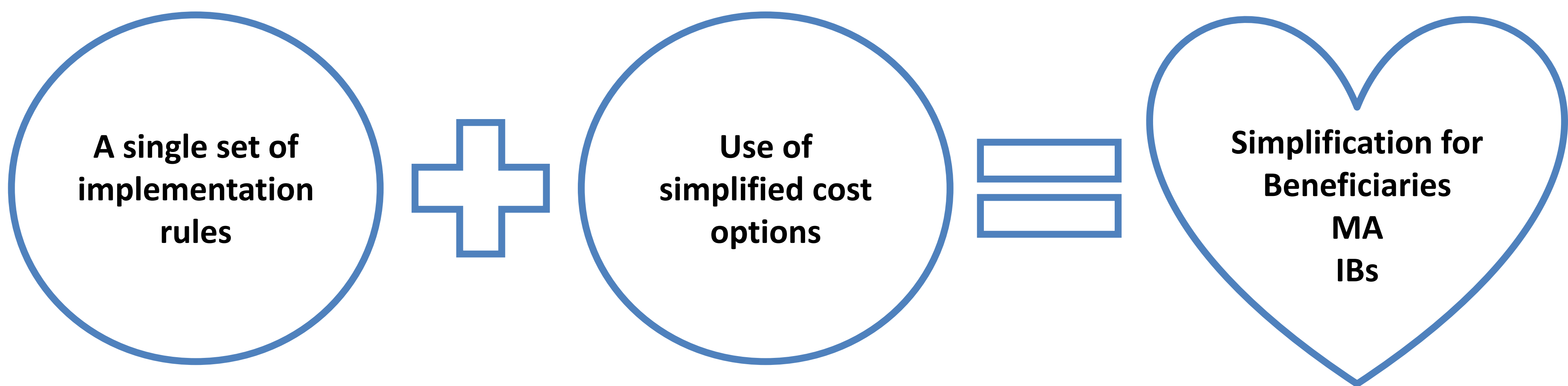
Heavy administrative burden due to overlapping implementation rules addressing the same subject e.g. durability, documents, revenue and project monitoring, i.e.

- EU Cohesion policy regulations
- Domestic rules set out in the NRW *Land* budget regulation and instrument-specific regulations

Simplified cost options were difficult to use due to specific domestic habits.



Goal



Solution



A *Land* regulation which transposes the ERDF regulation for 2014-20 into domestic law

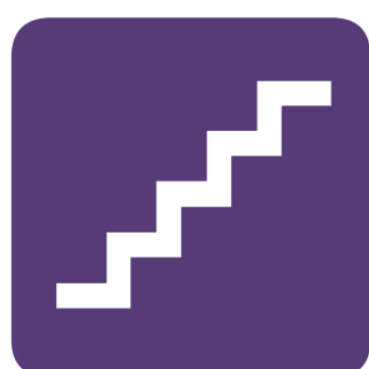
ERDF co-funded projects must only meet domestic rules if the specific subject is not addressed by the EU

Success factor



Political support, especially a *Land* government cabinet decision on the ERDF OP which included a commitment to an NRW *Land* regulation transposing ERDF rules into and replacing domestic law

Learning



- Importance of political support for significant administrative change
 - Simplification of some procedures due to a single set of rules
- BUT
- New administrative burden of EU Cohesion policy has consumed simplification!
